Position- Seasonal Farmhand

Job Summary

A position at our vegetable farm involves helping us seed, transplant, weed, and harvest. You'll be working alongside a small crew with a lot of hands-on learning. Farm work is production work. Our goal is to balance speed, high quality standards, and efficiency. A majority of our work is done by hand which can be physically challenging and sometimes uncomfortable. We work in the heat, rain, cold, and sometimes under time constraints. Most importantly though, we love what we do. The two of us farm because of the joy it brings to our lives. This position lends an opportunity to work outdoors, experience the surrounding nature and wildlife, become part of a small community of growers, and work along the changing seasons. We are seeking a team member that shares our values and work ethic!

Responsibilities

- Harvesting, washing, and packing produce
- Sowing seeds, watering, and caring for plants in the greenhouse
- Assisting with setting up and running irrigation
- May be asked to lead a task with other team members and/or volunteers
- Basic Field Work-
 - Weeding & hoeing
 - Hand watering
 - Transplanting crops
 - Installing row cover and moving sandbags
 - Trellis crops (like tomatoes & cucumbers)
 - General tool maintenance like cleaning and sharpening

Minimum Qualifications

Experience working outdoors is a must!

Knowledge of gardening and previous farming experience is a plus but is not required.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- General understanding of food safety
- Ability to work effectively and maintain deadlines with limited supervision
- Critical thinking and decision making skills
- Accountability and punctuality
- Basic math skills including arithmetic
- Ability to perform and interpret basic calculations related to count, weight, time, rate, and distance
- Basic skills involving reading and writing
- Ability to follow instructions and to ask for clarification
- Must perform comfortably in a group setting
- Must be detail oriented and focused
- Must be able to lift and move 35 lbs
- Ability to tolerate and work in various weather conditions such as: heat, humidity, wind, rain, cold, and muddy/wet conditions

Hours

- Part-time: 2 days per week at minimum
- Days per week: TBD based on applicant's availability (no weekends)
- Shift is 8am-4:30pm

Scheduling: Start and end times fluctuate based on the weather. In the heat we like to start earlier, and in the cold we tend to start later. In some instances, weekly adjustments have to be made in the case we have severe weather and need to postpone a shift.

Position Period

- June through October/November. Exact start and end dates are negotiable and are often weather dependent.
- We offer employees the option to work or take off on major holidays.

Compensation

- Pay starts at \$12 per hour (or more) based on experience and skill set
- We provide bonuses and/or raises for good performance and teamwork
- Employees have access to #2 grade and surplus produce. Worker CSA Share Available - Inquire!

How to Apply & Application Process

2. We review applications and qualified candidates are selected for a phone interview (~30 minutes).
3. We may then schedule a work trial day based on the previous interview. The work trial day is an opportunity for us and the candidate to evaluate each other while we perform real work. It's important that both parties judge whether working on our farm is a good fit. We pay you for the trial day.
4. Based on the interview, work trial day, and references we will either offer or deny employment.
